 Nearly everyone's way of life has been turned upside down, and most of us are experiencing withdrawal symptoms. But this is a great opportunity to ask ourselves, What am I really living for? Am I seeking first the kingdom of God, or am I caught up in trivial pursuits (Matthew 6:31-33)? Am I living to please myself or to please God?



# "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up." IT'S TIME TO CALL THE DOCTOR.

**Philippians 4:6** "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God."






Keep track of the things you're praying for, including Prayers that you create and Prayers that Friends have sent to you.
